Three finalists will be selected, with one winner receiving up to \$5,000 to go towards the school of his/her choosing.

In order to be eligible for the SFBAA Scholarship Program, the student must:

- Be a graduating high school senior in Dade, Broward or Palm Beach counties
- Have a minimum 3.0 weighted GPA
- Plan to continue education within the aviation sector (including, but not limited to, aeronautical science, aerospace engineering, air traffic management, aviation management, aircraft maintenance, or becoming a certified commercial pilot)
- Enroll in a college or vocational school on a full-time basis
- Explain in a carefully thought out essay, "Why are you entering the aviation industry and where do you see yourself 10 years from now?"
- Provide a letter of recommendation from a teacher/advisor/employer/etc.
